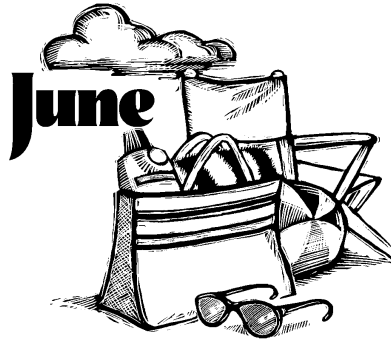

Brother **SALMON PAUL DANIELS, II** was an active youth member of Mount Zion. He graduated from high school and was preparing to go to college. He was the son of Dr. Paul Daniels.

Brother **JARRELL SPARKS**, the husband of Helen and the father of Beverly Tryon, Jeree and Vida Sparks, was a quiet-mannered person who provided for his family.

Deacon **CHARLES WILLIAMS** joined Mount Zion in 1930. He was very faithful and was ordained as a Deacon. He served in the choir, Sunday School and on many committees. He loved to sing.
