Sister **BEATRICE ROBERTSON** was indeed a leader, a circle president, choir president, music committee chairperson, and Vanguard supporter. But, beyond all that, she was a woman who always had a word of encouragement, full of joy, soft spoken, loved her pastor dearly and truly loved Mount Zion.

Reverend **ARTHUR THOMAS** will long be remembered as one of “God’s favorites.” He was very loyal as a great preacher, an assistant to Pastor Hill Sr., and a conductor of our 7:00 AM Early Worship Service. In his early years, he was a well-known boxer and was also known as a painter of beautiful artwork. We will forever remember his sweet demeanor with all of the members and his loyalty to Mount Zion.
