How could we ever forget the training of our former Pastor's "A Better Way to Celebrate Christmas." This lesson is available in the church lobby today for your personal review and group study during this month.

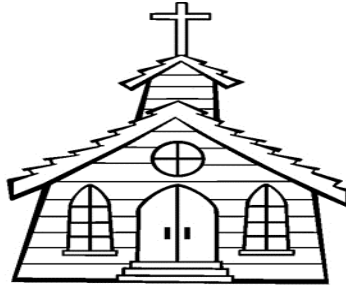
