Brother **AARON LANGRUM** was affectionately called “Papa” by our former Pastor. From the age of approximately four until eleven, he was the only father Pastor Hill Sr. knew. He and Mama reared him in their two-room log cabin in Sweet Home. He loved fishing, hunting, and telling jokes. He was the father of eight, nine including Pastor Hill. He was a hard worker and a sharecropper.

Brother **LARRY CATO** was a quiet-mannered man who went about doing good. He and his wife, Gloria, were faithful members of the Sons and Daughters Fellowship.

Sister **MARDIE MALONE** was a good wife, mother, worker and member of Mount Zion for over fifty years. She was a Sunday School teacher, Vacation Bible School and Backyard Bible School worker, choir member, circle member. She never had a frown on her face – only a smile.

Sister **ELIZABETH GREEN** was one of the great, sweet, consistent members of Mount Zion. She was a circle president. She had a smile that few people possessed.

Sister **GEORGIA ROSS** was one of the truly great spirits of Mount Zion. She was a laborer from the kitchen to the choir and as a circle president. She loved every aspect of the Lord’s work. She especially loved her Pastor. She was the sister of Deacon C. N. Ashley and the godmother of our current Pastor Edward V. Hill II. She was sweet and compassionate.

Deacon **YANCEY PERKINS** had the gift of humor and the gift of being a servant – whether it was picking up people (whom he called his “free loaders”), or cooking banana pudding, he did it with joy. He worked in the kitchen, at the Lord’s Kitchen, at the Fragment Center, chairman of the Noonday Prayer Meeting, deacon, choir member, Sunday School teacher, a contender for the faith, and one of the most generous givers our church has ever known.

Mother **MILDRA CALDWELL** was one of our oldest functioning members of Mount Zion who was a Sunday School worker, Released Time Education worker, Vacation Bible School worker, supporter of the Lord’s Kitchen, a delegate to and a charter member of the Western Baptist State Convention, and a member of Mount Zion for over 80 years. She was strong willed and determined and she fought hard to see our current Pastor take leadership of the church after his father’s death.

Sister **WILLIE MAE DAWKINS** was very dependable and always ready to serve wherever and whenever asked, even if it was just to wash the Lord’s Supper glasses after the first Sunday. She was a faithful First Aider.

Sister **SURRETHA GRANDBERRY** was the daughter of an outstanding preacher who pastored in the city of Los Angeles who worked in the training and education ministry of our church. At one time, she was the church clerk.

Brother **CLAUDE GREEN** became a member of Mount Zion in the mid 1930’s. He was a Sunday School student, Baptist Training Union member, a deacon, and a circle member. He was a helper to many people.

Sister **THELMA RAY WALKER** was a faithful, supportive, caring person – a very active usher until death. She was a friend of Pastor Hill, Sr. who helped train his daughter, Norva, beginning at four years old on how to be an usher.

Mother **ADA HENDERSON** loved to worship the Lord from sun-up to sun-down. She would sleep on the pew in order to not miss a service. She was faithful in the choirs of Zion and Sunday School. She often testified and shouted by screaming, “Thank you; thank you, Sir!”

Sister **LEOLA WOMACK** was a faithful member who reared her entire family at Mount Zion. The Womack family have been loyal neighbors and friends to our church. Her husband was Deacon Rubin Womack and her faithful daughter, Linda, is still among us.

Sister **ALICE FREDRICK** was a long time member of Mount Zion who served as an usher, president of the First Aiders, and a circle president.

Deacon **LOUIS THOMPSON** was a true servant of the Lord who served the church as director of choirs, deacon, trustee, Sunday School superintendent, noon-day prayer partner, transportation committee, Vanguard leader, Lord’s Kitchen worker, and a very generous contributor.

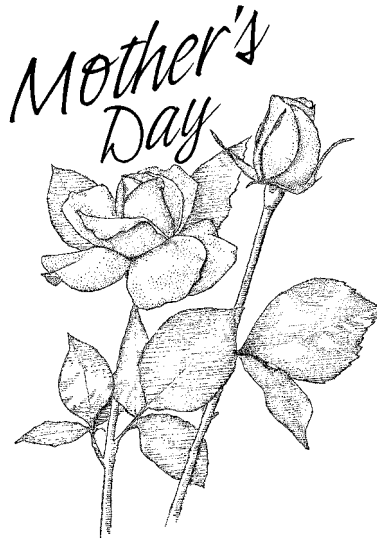

Fishing Report

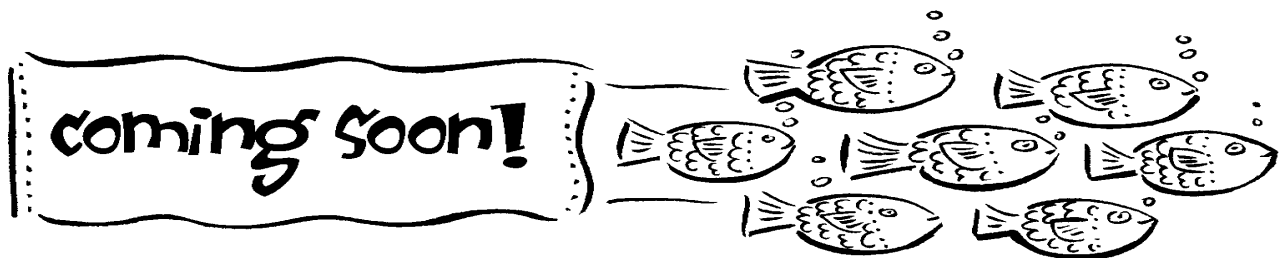
We had a total of 31 visitors invited by members of Mount Zion during April. 8 of these visitors joined the church. Praise the Lord!

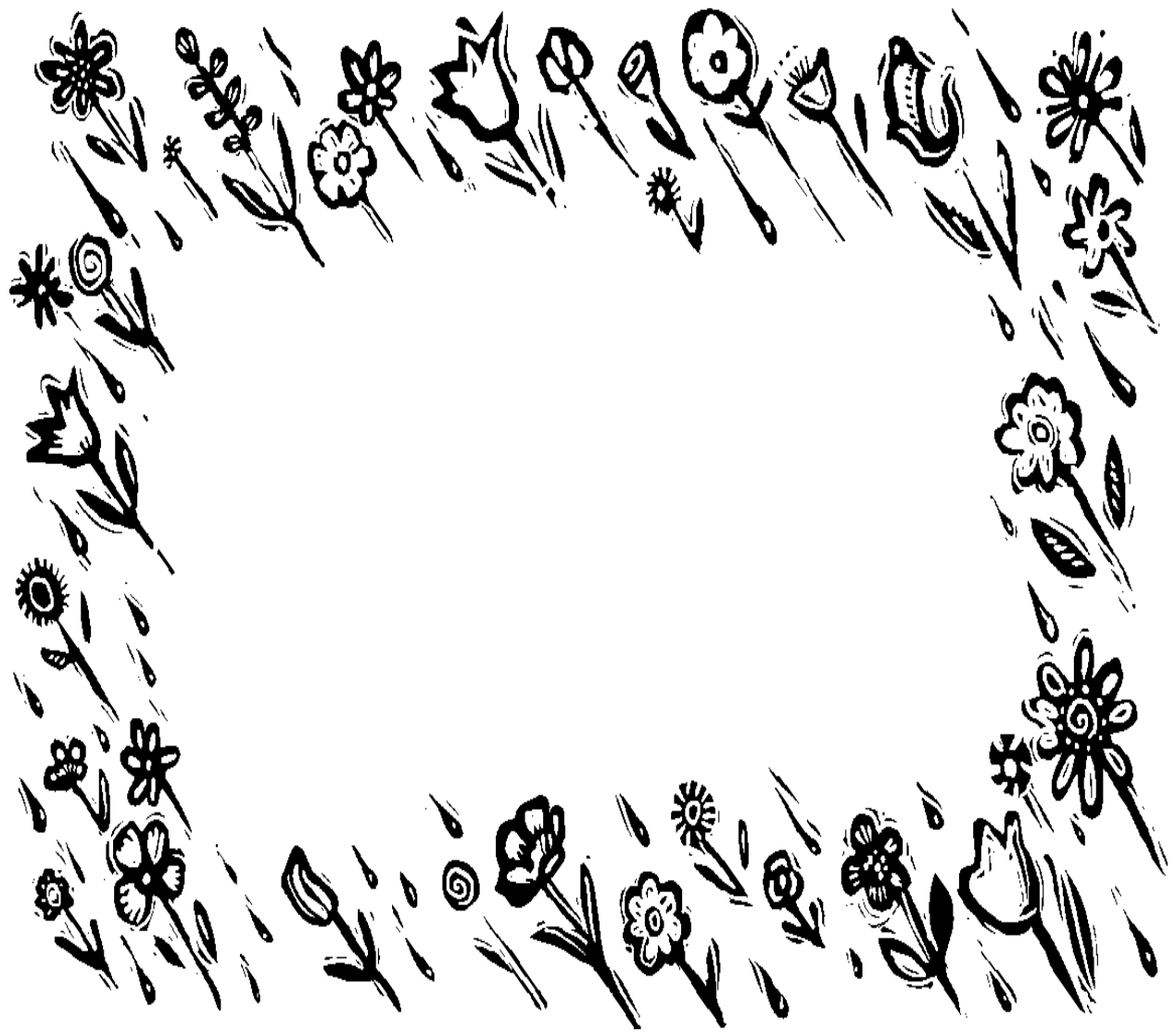

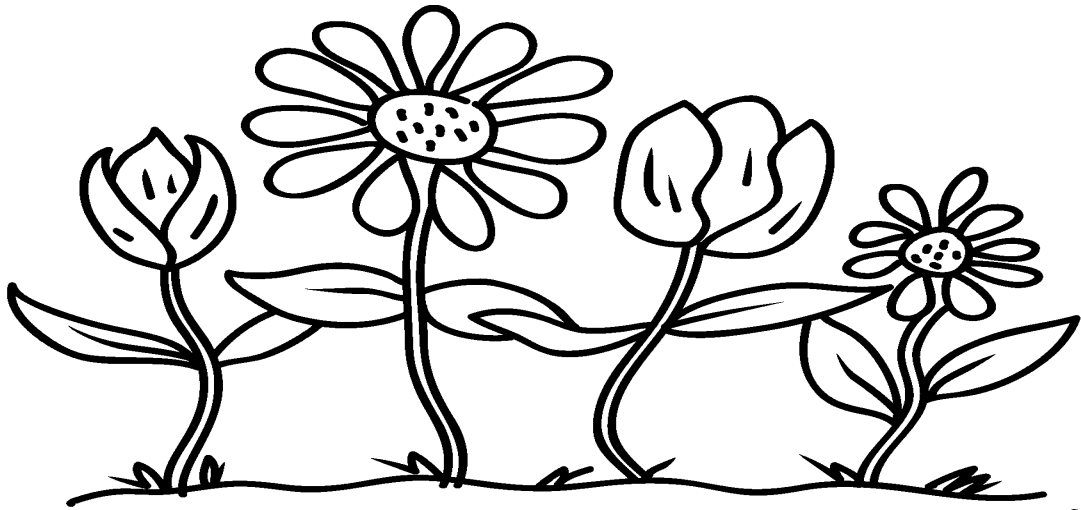
