The boxes are available today after morning worship. Plan to turn in your boxes by next Sunday and encourage your whole family to get involved.

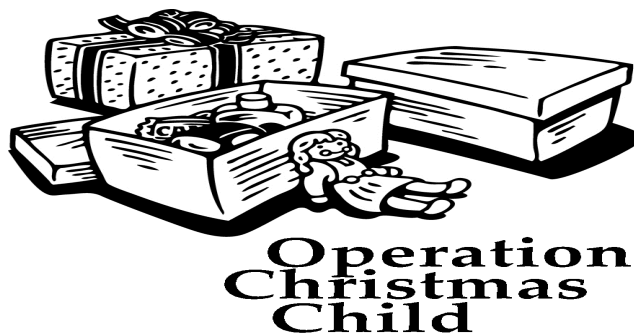
