Christmas Outreach Project 2014

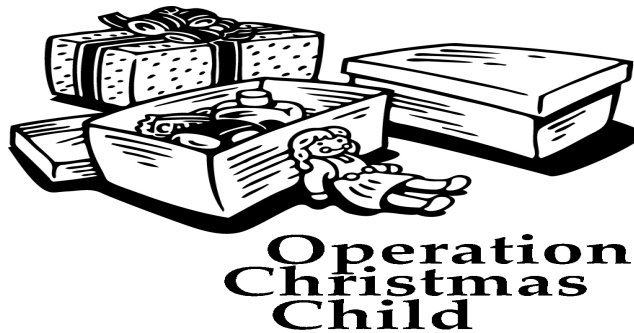
